She was always doing good and helping the poor. She became sick and died.

A Case Study in Death and Resurrection: Acts 9:32-43 ...

Conversion: In Acts chapter 9 we experience the power of conversion, and specifically conversion as a type of resurrection in Jesus Christ, a spiritual resurrection. Conversion is a moment of one’s salvation but not the whole of it. Conversion is the moment when we believe in the name of Jesus and have faith in his life, death, and resurrection.

But when the Lord returns and orders us to arrive, it will be with all the confidence of the omnipotent God. The RESULTS of Peter’s command was Tabitha’s resurrection.

In verse 43 Luke adds what seems like an unimportant footnote, but actually it is an indicator of the great work God had already done in Peter in preparing him for what was to occur very soon. 43 And it came about that he stayed many days in Joppa with a certain tanner, Simon.
